Instructions for Submission Form, Specimen Collection, and Delivery to Lab

Use the following guidelines to complete your submission form, collect and label each specimen, and deliver the samples to a PADLS lab for testing as outlined below.

<u>General Submission Form</u>: This form is available on the PADLS Website http://padls.agriculture.pa.gov/PdfFiles/forms/GeneralSubmissionForm.pdf

Complete your submission form section by section as outlined below.

- Bill To section: Mark Other and write in 'Program Testing'.
- <u>Purpose of Testing</u> section: Mark Other and write in 'MMIT'
- <u>Veterinarian/Submitter</u> section: Write the name of the submitter (can be same as Owner)
- <u>Owner</u> section: Write in all information (<u>use the barcode labels supplied</u>) including:

'Company name',

'Premises ID', (USDA issued Premises ID – supplied on the barcode labels and begins with 2 zeros, '00')

'Address',

'Contact information' (Phone, Fax and E-mail)

'Preferred Report Distribution Method' (US Mail, Fax, E-mail, No Report)

- <u>Animal Information</u> section: Mark *Bovine*
- <u>Test(s) Requested</u> section: Write in 'AI PCR'.
- Animal Identification section:

Official Animal ID/Name column: Write in unique 'Tanker ID' for each sample Breed column: Write in the 'Number of Farms' represented in the tanker

• <u>Specimen Information</u> section:

Collection date: Write in the 'Date' that your specimen was collected

Specimen Type: Mark Other and write in 'Tanker Milk'

Specimen Collection:

- Write the 'Company Name' and the unique 'Tanker ID' on the specimen tube using a
 permanent marker. Ensure that it can be easily read at the receiving laboratory. See
 example below. It is critical that the specimen labeling matches the information on the
 submission form.
- Use aseptic technique to collect and place at least 10 ml of milk from the tanker into a 15 ml conical screw cap tube (supplied), closing the tube firmly.
- Refrigerate samples immediately. Place all tubes into a specimen bag for shipping.

Delivery to an approved diagnostic laboratory:

- NOTE: All specimens must arrive at the lab on a regular business day, and within 48 hours of collection. Avoid shipping on a Friday or any day prior to a major holiday.
- Specimens, in the specimen bag, should be placed in an insulated shipping container with frozen ice pack(s). Include the completed submission form in a separate bag in the shipping container.
- Ship container, for overnight delivery, to the **Animal Diagnostic Laboratory**, **Penn State University**, **131 Pastureview Road**, **University Park**, **PA 16802** using one of the pre-paid, pre-addressed, shipping labels provided. (Please use the UPS shipping labels in consecutive order.)
